There will be a public information session held upstairs in the main hall at the Amherst Fire Station located at 70 Albion Street in Amherst on Thursday, March 4, 2010 from 9:30 am until 12 o'clock noon.

The purpose of the information session is to present an overview of the recent changes to the Nova Scotia Building Code. As of January 1, 2010 the Nova Scotia Building Code Regulations adopted a new Part which address' Resource Conservation. This new Part in the Code makes energy efficiency for buildings a Code requirement and this information session will give specific details on how to achieve compliance with the new Code.

This information session is open to the public but the information presented will be especially useful to anyone who is planning to build a new dwelling, renovate an existing dwelling or add an addition to an existing dwelling.

There is no charge to attend the information session but it would be helpful if anyone who is planning to attend could contact their local Building Official and let them know that you are planning to attend. This will help us to be better prepared. Refreshments and a nutrition break will be provided.
